

Sound Regulations in Norway

From the Live DMA Working Group “Music is no noise! – Sound regulations for live music scenes in Europe” that took place in February 2019.

Inside the venue:

Recommendation from National department of health: 99dB (average 30 min) and 130dB peak. Not a law, it is up to each city or county to regulate this, although many follow the recommendation. Small venues: have a house rule at 102dB over 15 min.
