Inside the venue:

Sweden has a limit of 100 dB as average that you aren't allowed to exceed over time. When we have kids under 13 the limit is 97dB. At some places (a certain festival) the local authorities allows kids under 13 to be at the festival with ear protection.

Outside the venue:

Complementary measures:

Most venues in Sweden have meters and the sound level is measured.
